Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order at 11:03am by Jefferson County Public Hospital District No. 2 chair, Commissioner Buhler. Present were Jefferson County Public Hospital District No. 2 Commissioners Dressler, Kolff, Ready, and McComas. 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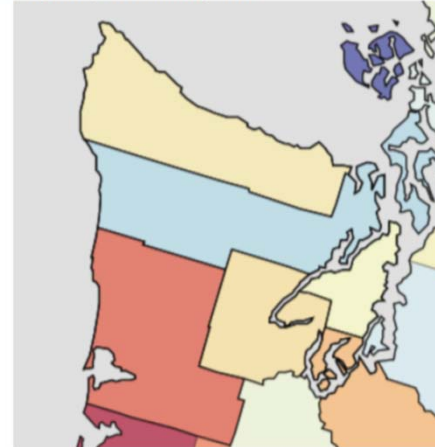

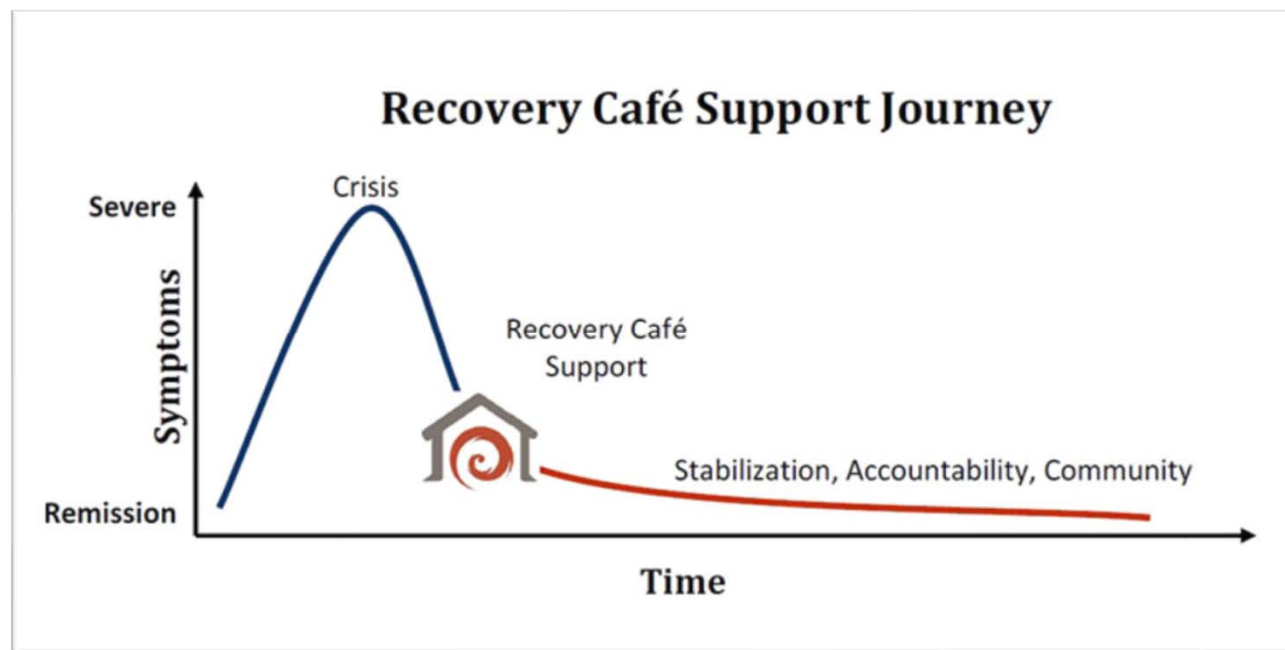

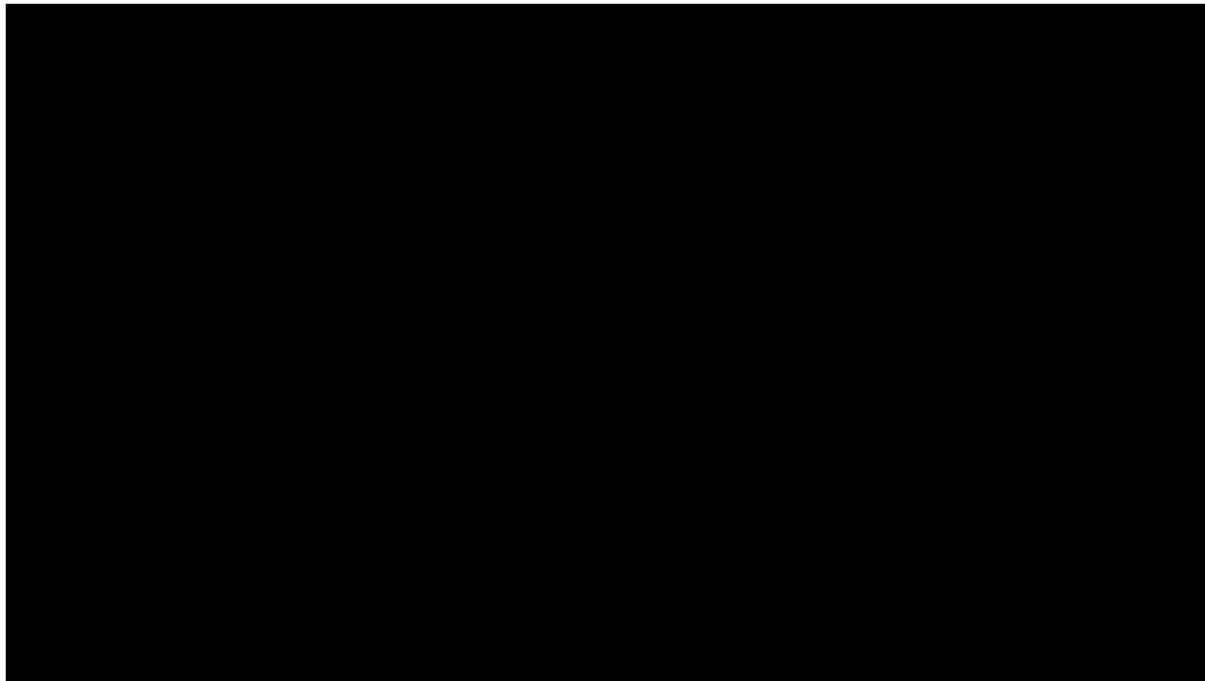


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Dr. Locke Discusses the Opioid Crisis



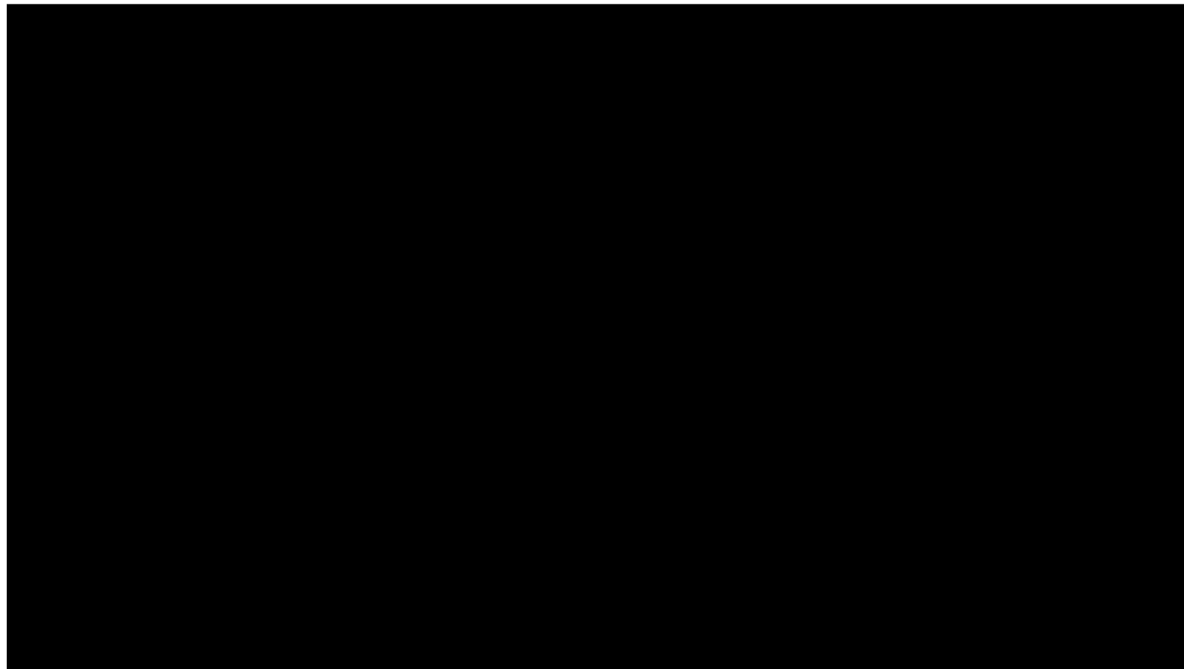

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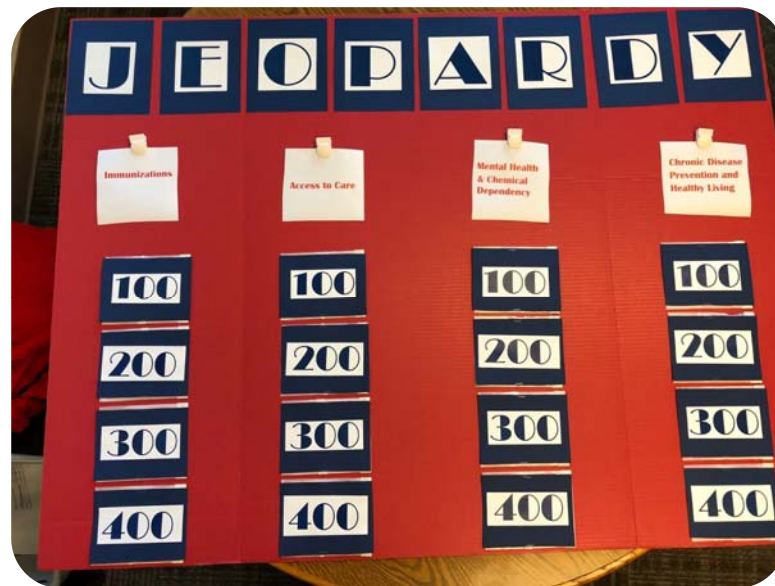
