Dial-A-Ride is a no-cost option if you have a disability that prevents you from using a fixed route bus service and you are within $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from a fixed route. Riders must apply before making reservations. Reservations are required in advance; call to schedule. Dial-A-Ride is zero-fare and for in-county transport only.

ECHHO (ECUMENICAL CHRISITAN HELPING HANDS)

Volunteers provide door-to-door, no-cost travel to medical appointments. Call at least two weeks in advance to schedule. Must be able to get in and out of vehicles with minimal assistance or be accompanied by a caregiver who can assist. Service can be used for out-of-county appointments.
